## **A Friend in Need**

Many of you know that Maggie Loving and Clover Leaf Equestrian Center relocated to Minden several months ago. Unfortunately, shortly after the move, and in the middle of building a new equestrian facility, Maggie became ill. She has lost about 35 pounds and while trying her best to keep teaching, she cannot ride. After a couple of grueling and costly months of inconclusive diagnostic testing, Maggie finally has been diagnosed with Lyme Disease. She currently has a long term indwelling intravenous catheter and visits the hospital daily to receive a 45 minute IV antibiotic infusion. This will continue for at least 6 months, possibly longer. While Maggie does have insurance, many of the medical costs associated with diagnosing and treating her illness are not covered. Therefore, we are calling upon our equine community to give Maggie any support possible to speed her recovery.

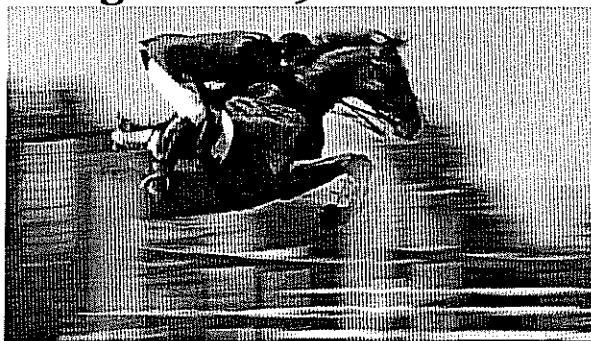

## **A note on health and fitness from a fellow equestrian and SNHSA Board member....**

I'd like to let you all know that I am now a Certified Animal Physical Therapist, only 1 of 5 in the state of Nevada. I have been a practicing human PT for 19 years. I became interested in animal PT in 2003 and began the process to become certified in 2004. Animal Rehabilitation is a growing field of collaborative effort between veterinarians and physical therapists. The goal is to help horses recover more fully and possibly faster from injury or disease. As with humans a physical therapist also plays a part in achieving optimal levels of fitness for sport specific use. If you or your horse has an injury that needs attention or you want to improve your level of performance, consider a physical therapy consultation. For a course of rehabilitation a veterinary referral is required. Please call with any questions about you or your horse. Stay healthy together!

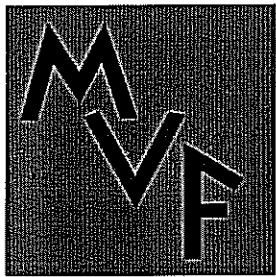
